One item from Primary and two items from Secondary, OR Two items from Primary and one item from Secondary. At least one item verifying your current South Australian residential address and signature

Documents must be originals and issued within the allowable time.

You must have an original of at least 1 Primary Evidence

All primary evidence of identity documents must be in original hard copy/physical format

Secondary evidence of identity documents may be presented either in hard copy/physical or digital format. Electronic statements accessed through your account on an app on your device (e.g. mobile phone or tablet) and internet-printed statements are acceptable

What is not accepted

- Anything that has your name spelt differently to your **Category A Documents**.
- Anything that is not within required time frame
- White Card
- Library card
- Letters from Telstra, Optus, AGL etc. (A bill is accepted)
- ID letter from ALRM
- Photo, photocopy or screenshot of anything even if it is certified by a JP.
- **Any other document that is not on the MR583 Evidence of Identity document**

Understanding the Rules

In order to deliver the Learner's Permit test and sign you off with a pass on the Service SA paperwork, TAFESA is required to follow the same ID rules that are in place at Service SA

- Names on all documents must be spelled exactly the same way.
- Addresses on all documents must be exactly the same.
There is no leeway with this rule.
- TAFESA must sight and copy the original ID documents. We need to know that you actually have original documents before we allow you to sit the Learner's test.
The reason for this is that once you pass the test at TAFESA, you are still required to take your original documents to Service SA when you apply for your Learner's Permit.
- At least one of the three documents presented will need to provide evidence of your current South Australian address. If none of the documents display the address an additional document will be required.
- Documents that list middle names as an initial will need to be supported by another acceptable primary document which shows what the initial stands for
