## **END OF SPECIAL ADMINISTRATION**

On 20 September 2019, a delegate of the Registrar of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Corporations (**the Registrar**) made a determination under division 487 of the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006 (CATSI Act)* that the Kokatha Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC (ICN 8093) (**the corporation**) would be under special administration from 12:01am (ACST) on Monday, 23 September 2019 until 11:59pm (ACST) on Friday, 27 March 2020.

The special administration was then extended a further two times and will end at 11:59 pm on Friday, 9 October 2020. After this time the control of the corporation's affairs will rest with the directors who have been appointed by the special administrator using his powers under section 499-5(3)(d) of the CATSI Act.

The persons who have been appointed as directors of the corporation and specialist directors by the special administrator are:

At the 2022 AGM half of the directors' appointments will expire. The directors will decide by resolution at a directors' meeting prior to the 2022 AGM as to which directors will be standing down. They will be eligible to be re-elected. The remaining directors' appointments will expire at the 2023 AGM. All new directors appointed at the 2022 AGM will be appointed for a term of two years. The AGM minutes must record the term of each director appointed.

I understand that the special administrator has provided a handover report to the corporation in relation to the various matters dealt with during the period of the special administration and information about the corporation's current operating environment.

The Registrar will be monitoring the corporation closely over the next 12 months to ensure it properly transitions back to normal operations. A determination made under section 336-1 of the CATSI Act, which sets out in detail the reports and information that is required, will be issued to the corporation shortly.

I ask that the directors carry out their functions and exercise their powers with full care and diligence and in the best interests of the corporation.
