## The Past

KAC and other community organisations tried and failed to get RARB status

Failed, costly, time consuming

**Needed to change approach**

## What we did

**Sought feedback**

Aboriginal Affairs and Reconciliation (AAR) offered support and guidance

AAR advice was to match KAC policies to Aboriginal Heritage Act policy requirements

## What happened

**Changed focus**

KAC Board of Directors focused attention on this area

Developed Policies to match requirements

**KAC appointed RARB status on 29 October 2021**

## The future

Success of RARB is now in the hands of Kokatha People Culture and Heritage Committee (as Family Representatives) now have leading and active role in supporting the successful implementation of the RARB
